



Population and dwellings

Number of people counted

- 1,560 people usually live in Mangatainoka. This is a decrease of 6 people, or less than one percent, since the 2006 Census.
- Mangatainoka has 9.3 percent of Tararua District's population.

Number of dwellings counted

- There are 621 occupied dwellings and 66 unoccupied dwellings in Mangatainoka.
- For Tararua District as a whole, there are 6,858 occupied dwellings and 939 unoccupied dwellings.
- There are 0 dwellings under construction in Mangatainoka, and 27 under construction in Tararua District.

Note: This time series is irregular. Because the 2011 Census was cancelled after the Canterbury earthquake on 22 February 2011, the gap between this census and the last one is seven years. The change in the data between 2006 and 2013 may be greater than in the usual five-year gap between censuses. Be careful when comparing trends.


Age and sex

Total population

- The median age (half are younger, and half older, than this age) is 39.3 years for people in Mangatainoka. The median age in Tararua District is 41.5 years.
- 10.8 percent of people in Mangatainoka are aged 65 years and over, compared with 17.0 percent of the total Tararua District population.
- 22.3 percent of people are aged under 15 years in Mangatainoka, compared with 22.0 percent for all of Tararua District.

Broad age group and sex of people



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Cultural diversity

Ethnic groups

- The most common ethnic group in Mangatainoka is European, compared with European for Tararua District as a whole.

Birthplace

- 7.1 percent of people in Mangatainoka were born overseas, compared with 8.3 percent for Tararua District as a whole.
- For people born overseas who are now living in Mangatainoka, the most common birthplace was UK and Ireland, compared with UK and Ireland for people born overseas in all of Tararua District.

Languages spoken

- After English, the next most common language spoken in Mangatainoka is te reo Māori, which was spoken by 1.2 percent of people. For Tararua District as a whole, the most common language apart from English is te reo Māori, spoken by 4.6 percent of people.
- New Zealand Sign Language is used by less than one percent of people in Mangatainoka, compared with less than one percent of people for all of Tararua District.
- 94.1 percent of people in Mangatainoka speak only one language, compared with 90.9 percent of people for all of Tararua District.

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
Relationship status

Total population aged 15 years and over

- 28.0 percent of people aged 15 years and over living in Mangatainoka have never married, 58.3 percent are married, and 13.7 percent are separated, divorced or widowed.
- 35.3 percent of people in Mangatainoka aged 15 years and over who have never been married live with a partner.

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
Qualifications

Total population aged 15 years and over

- 76.5 percent of people aged 15 years and over in Mangatainoka have a formal qualification, compared with 66.9 percent in Tararua District.
- In Mangatainoka, 12.1 percent of people aged 15 years and over held a bachelor's degree or higher as their highest qualification, compared with 8.9 percent for Tararua District as a whole.


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Work

Total population aged 15 years and over

- The unemployment rate in Mangatainoka is 4.0 percent for people aged 15 years and over, compared with 6.1 percent for all of Tararua District.
- The most common occupational group in Mangatainoka is 'managers', and 'managers' is the most common occupational group in Tararua District.

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
Income

Total population aged 15 years and over

- For people aged 15 years and over, the median income (half earn more, and half less, than this amount) in Mangatainoka is \$31,700. This compares with a median of \$25,100 for all of Tararua District.
- 34.9 percent of people aged 15 years and over in Mangatainoka have an annual income of \$20,000 or less, compared with 40.2 percent of people for Tararua District as a whole.
- In Mangatainoka, 27.9 percent of people aged 15 years and over have an annual income of more than \$50,000, compared with 19.5 percent of people in Tararua District.


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Families

Family type

- Couples with children make up 39.4 percent of all families in Mangatainoka, while couples without children make up 47.7 percent of all families.
- In Tararua District, couples with children make up 37.0 percent of all families, while couples without children make up 46.0 percent of all families.
- 12.9 percent of families in Mangatainoka are one parent with children families, while one parent with children families make up 17.0 percent of families for Tararua District as a whole.


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Households

Household composition

- One-family households make up 76.5 percent of all households in Mangatainoka. For Tararua District as a whole, one-family households make up 67.1 percent of all households.
- In Mangatainoka, there are 129 one-person households making up 21.5 percent of all households. In Tararua District, one-person households make up 28.8 percent of all households.
- The average household size in Mangatainoka is 2.5 people, compared with an average of 2.4 people per household for all of Tararua District.

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Phone, fax, and Internet


Access to phones, fax machines, and Internet

- 74.2 percent of households in Mangatainoka have access to the Internet, compared with 64.2 percent of households in Tararua District.
- In Mangatainoka, 80.3 percent of households have access to a cellphone, compared with 76.8 percent of households for Tararua District as a whole.


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Transport

Access to motor vehicles

- 19.6 percent of households in Mangatainoka have access to three or more motor vehicles, compared with 15.6 percent of all households in Tararua District.

Main means of travel to work

- The most common means of travel to work on census day for people in Mangatainoka was driving a private car, truck or van (60.8 percent of people who travelled to work used this form of transport).
- This was followed by driving a company car, truck or van (14.5 percent) and motor cycle or power cycle (13.9 percent).
- For Tararua District as a whole, the most common means of travel to work was driving a private car, truck or van, followed by driving a company car, truck or van and walking or jogging.

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Housing


Home ownership

- In Mangatainoka, 64.1 percent of households in occupied private dwellings owned the dwelling or held it in a family trust.
- For Tararua District as a whole, 67.1 percent of households in occupied private dwellings owned the dwelling or held it in a family trust.
- For households in Mangatainoka who rented the dwelling that they lived in, the median weekly rent paid was \$120. This compared with \$160 for Tararua District.

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Building consents

Building consent data for the year ended December 2013 showed that:

- The total number of building consents issued for dwellings, including apartments, in Mangatainoka was 3.
- The total number of building consents issued for apartments in Mangatainoka was 0.
- The total value of residential building work in Mangatainoka was \$1,511,225.
- The total value of non-residential building work in Mangatainoka was \$545,780.

Note: Building consent data is obtained from all accredited building consent authorities (ie territorial authorities) and is compiled if the building consent issued is valued over \$5000. See data quality information on building consents.

Business

Business demographics

Business demographic data for the year ended February 2013 showed that:

- There were 458 business locations (geographic units) in Mangatainoka compared with 2,936 for all of Tararua District. This is an increase of 4.1 percent from the year ended February 2006 for Mangatainoka.
- There were 720 paid employees in Mangatainoka compared with 6,130 for all of Tararua District. This is an increase of 26.3 percent from the year ended February 2006 for Mangatainoka.
